#### 1. Introduction

At *The Collective*, we are dedicated to protecting your privacy and safeguarding your personal data. This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, share, and protect your information in compliance with relevant legislation, including but not limited to:

#### 2. Data We Collect

The Collective will not share individual usage data or personal programme details with employers or external parties. Aggregated, anonymous data may be used for reporting purposes, allowing us to demonstrate platform impact while maintaining your confidentiality.

Your data's security is our priority. We implement technical and organisational measures to protect against unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

## 6. Your Rights
